We operate on the Chatham House Rule whereby all information and discussion is non-attributable i.e. participants are free to use the information received, but neither the identity nor the affiliation of the speaker(s), nor that of any other participant, may be revealed outside of the meeting. The group has been successful in attracting speakers from across the gamut of air transport and airline industry professionals to gain a ranging perspective and varying points of view designed to help elicit discussion and debate. The meetings usually attract around 40-50+ delegates and are often lively and engaging with an emphasis on discussing key issues and current events affecting the industry
